I have a vb.net form and I need it to link to the page The PHP page contains a "select" list that is populated with the IDs of all of my Programme IDs and their corresponding name. The problem is that the page will load with Programme1 selected in the "select" list. I need to be able to reprogramme the URL on the page so that it links to the ID of the Programme I have selected. Obviously, I can not modify the PHP code as I don't have access to it. Is it possible to do this purely in the vb.net code of my form? A: Yes. Use the HttpWebRequest and HttpWebResponse classes. Supposing that the URL for the page is you can request the page using the following code: Dim objRequest As System.Net.HttpWebRequest = DirectCast(WebRequest.Create(""), HttpWebRequest) Dim objRequest As System.Net.HttpWebResponse = DirectCast(objRequest.GetResponse(), HttpWebResponse) You can then assign the appropriate value to the "programmes" variable of the PHP page: L programme selected = "1" And then output to the screen using standard HTML.
